Trinity Presbyterian Church Inclement Weather Policy

Sunday Church Services -

- A. In the event that inclement weather / a winter storm occurs or is likely to occur <u>before</u> the start of regularly scheduled Sunday School and Worship Services (these activities occur each Sunday, between the hours of 9:00 am to 12:00 pm), the Elders of Trinity Presbyterian Church (TPC) will (1) call the Weather Closing Hotline at 410-222-7312 and/or (2) check the Anne Arundel Parks and Rec website (www.aacounty.org/RecParks/cancellation.cfm). The availability of the school (open or closed) will be (1) sent out by email to each attendee at TPC for whom we have an email, and (2) posted on our website.
- B. In the event that inclement weather / a winter storm occurs <u>during</u> our regularly scheduled worship services, the Elders of TPC will decide when or if to end the Lord's Day activities, and notify everyone in the facility. Guidance or instructions from the County to close the school take priority over any local TPC guidance.

Ministries -

- A. In the event that inclement weather / a winter storm occurs or is likely to occur <u>before</u> the start of a scheduled TPC Ministry Event (Small Group Meeting, Session Meeting, etc), the person responsible for that meeting will be responsible to announce whether the planned event will still be conducted, or not.
- B. If Anne Arundel County Schools or Prince George's County Schools are closed, ministry events scheduled during the week will be cancelled.
- C. In the event that inclement weather / a winter storm occurs <u>during</u> a TCP Ministry Event, the person responsible for that meeting will be responsible to decide whether to continue with the event or to end it, and will notify all attendees accordingly.
